- Demonstrated effective verbal and written skills with emphasis on interpersonal communication skills, confidentiality and record keeping
- Demonstrated understanding of a holistic approach to mental health
- Demonstrated capacity to work effectively as part of a trans-disciplinary team
- Capacity to work under pressure and develop creative and flexible solutions to complex problems
