WHO CAN BE VACCINATED AT VAHS?

If you are an Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander person aged 12 years and over, you can have a COVID vaccination at VAHS.

National guidelines currently recommend Pfizer vaccine for people aged 12 to 59 years. Astra Zeneca is recommended for people aged 60 years and over, and for people who have already had a first dose of Astra Zeneca.

Non-Aboriginal people can be vaccinated at VAHS if they are: members of Aboriginal families, carers of Aboriginal people, or staff of Aboriginal community organisations and their families.

HOW TO MAKE AN APPOINTMENT

If you are aged 12-59 years, you can arrange a Pfizer vaccination by

- Booking an appointment at Fitzroy on 9419 3000 (option 1)
- Booking an appointment at Epping on 8592 3920
- Walking in to VAHS Fitzroy between 10 and 12 Mondays to Saturdays or 4.30 to 6pm Tuesdays

If you are aged 60 years and over or have already had your first dose, book an Astra Zeneca appointment at Fitzroy on 9419 3000 or Epping on 8592 3920.

MORE INFORMATION

- Please cancel your appointment if you can't attend.
- Wear clothing that will make it easy to access your upper arm.
- You will have an assessment before your vaccination and will need to stay 15 mins afterwards for observation.
- You can make an appointment for your second dose when you attend for your first.
- Your appointment is only for a Covid vaccination; you will need another appointment for any other care.
- Please don't attend VAHS if you have Covid symptoms or have visited an exposure site.
