- Certificate 3 in Aboriginal Health Work or other related qualifications
- A demonstrated appreciation of a range of social impacts and determinants impacting Aboriginal Social Emotional Wellbeing e.g., Impacts of Colonization, grief/loss, homelessness, complex family issues, mental illness, its impact, support needs and recovery strategies.
- An understanding of services provided by the Aboriginal Health & Wellbeing Services, mainstream health services and mental health services.
- At least three years in a similar role with high level case management skills.
- Experience in a health/social emotional related multi-disciplinary team would be an advantage
- Demonstrated skills in communicating and working with a range of people and organization's such as families, self-help, and mutual aid groups, referring agencies including forensic services and other treatment, support and social services.
- Good organization and time management skills
