- Knowledge and understanding of the effect of trans generational violence and trauma on Aboriginal men and their families.
- Demonstrated experience in work with Aboriginal Men.
- Strong communication, advocacy and written skills that demonstrate a capacity to negotiate and communicate with a wide range of professionals and individuals
- Good time management skills with a pro-active approach to timely follow up and completion of tasks
- The demonstrated ability to work effectively as part of a multi skilled team.
- Fully approved Covid 19 Vaccinations (including booster)
