Essential

- Understanding of and commitment to the Aboriginal Community
- Understanding of Aboriginal Community Controlled Health Services and the issues facing these organisations
- Demonstrated experience in networking and liaising with relevant Commonwealth and State government departments and agencies, as well as non-government organisations
- High level experience in Aboriginal health policy and an understanding of holistic health
- Previous experience in health-related data management including population health needs assessment, strategic population health planning and program/service evaluation
- Demonstrated ability to communicate and liaise effectively with a wide range of stakeholders, including GPs, researchers, service managers and community representatives
- Demonstrated ability to research and analyse complex material, summarise key issues and develop innovative and creative solutions

- Demonstrated ability to prepare technical, descriptive, analytical population health summarise and reports, including presenting data in meaningful formats
- Ability to think strategically and creatively
