About the Opportunity

- Actively communicate and coordinate with other VAHS GPs, allied health professionals and specialist services when engaged in multidisciplinary care planning.
- Refer patients to other providers both within VAHS and / or external as appropriate.
- Maintain detailed and accurate patient records and documentation
- Adhere to the VAHS AGPAL accreditation program, processes and policies.
- Participate in the implementation and ongoing review and revision of a comprehensive clinical governance framework for the organization.
- Maximize Medicare Billings / claims through effective and timely Clinic patient records processes.

Prerequisites

- Minimum 5 years General Practitioner experience with Vocational Registration (RACGP, FRACGP, FACRIRM or equivalent)
- Current unconditional registration as a medical practitioner with AHPRA
- Eligible for Medicare Provider Number
- Comply with VAHS Immunisation Policy and various infection control policy and procedures.
